WARNING

UNDER THE FAIR TRADING ACT 1999

Under section 32N of the *Fair Trading*

Act 1999, the supplier is entitled to ask you to agree that these conditions do not apply to you. If you sign this form, you will be agreeing that your rights to sue the supplier under the *Fair Trading Act* 1999 if you are killed or injured because the services were not rendered with due care and skill or they were not reasonably fit for their purpose, are excluded, restricted or modified in the way set out in this form.

NOTE: The change to your rights, as set out in this form, does not apply if your death or injury is due to gross negligence on the supplier's part. "Gross negligence" is defined in the *Fair Trading (Recreational Services) Regulations* 2004.
